What is a Request for Tender?

A RFT generally consists of four parts:

- 1. Conditions of Tender
- 2. Specification
- 3. Conditions of Contract
- 4. Tender Form

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...BUT you all know that already!

What you choose as **your key deliverable** makes a big difference to how you set the mandatory & weighted evaluation criteria and minimum scores.

Your key deliverable must be included in the mandatory evaluation criteria.

How to align the evaluation process to your key stakeholder's expectations...

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And hopefully, they're the same!

Your key stakeholder(s) may each have a number of deliverables, some of which may be competing or even, mutually exclusive.

The priority of deliverables must be established before the mandatory evaluation criteria are chosen.

This may be decided by the hierarchy of the stakeholders?

Manager vs Peer vs End User

What you choose as **your key deliverable** makes a big difference to how you set the mandatory & weighted evaluation criteria.

Mandatory Criteria

- Reduced Costs
- 5 Star ANCAP
- 5 Year Warranty
- Roadside Assist

Weighted Criteria	(%)
 Tender Price 	30%
 Safety 	25%
 Quality 	25%
 End Users 	10%
 Fixed Price Servicing 	5%
 Dealer Network 	5%

Weighted evaluation criteria may also have a stipulated Minimum Score which is the minimum acceptable result that will allow the tenderer to continue in the tender evaluation process.

Mandatory Criteria

- Reduced Costs
- 5 Star ANCAP
- 5 Year Warranty
- Roadside Assist

Minimum Scores

- Safety >15%
- Quality >15%

Weighted Criteria	(%)
 Tender Price 	30%
 Safety 	25%
 Quality 	25%
 End Users 	10%
 Fixed Price Servicing 	5%
 Dealer Network 	5%

Weighted evaluation criteria should be developed to assess systemic monitoring, recording and reporting of KPIs.

Mandatory Criteria

- Reduced Costs
- 5 Star ANCAP
- 5 Year Warranty
- Roadside Assist

Minimum Scores

- Safety >15%
- Quality >15%

Weighted Criteria	(%)
 Tender Price 	30%
Safety	25%
 Quality 	
 Extended Warranty 	10%
KPI Systems	5%
Balance	10%
 End Users 	10%
 Fixed Price Servicing 	5%
 Dealer Network 	5%

Key deliverables should be linked to objective KPIs, wherever practicable.

Recording and periodic reporting of KPIs should be identified as a contract obligation for the successful tenderer.
