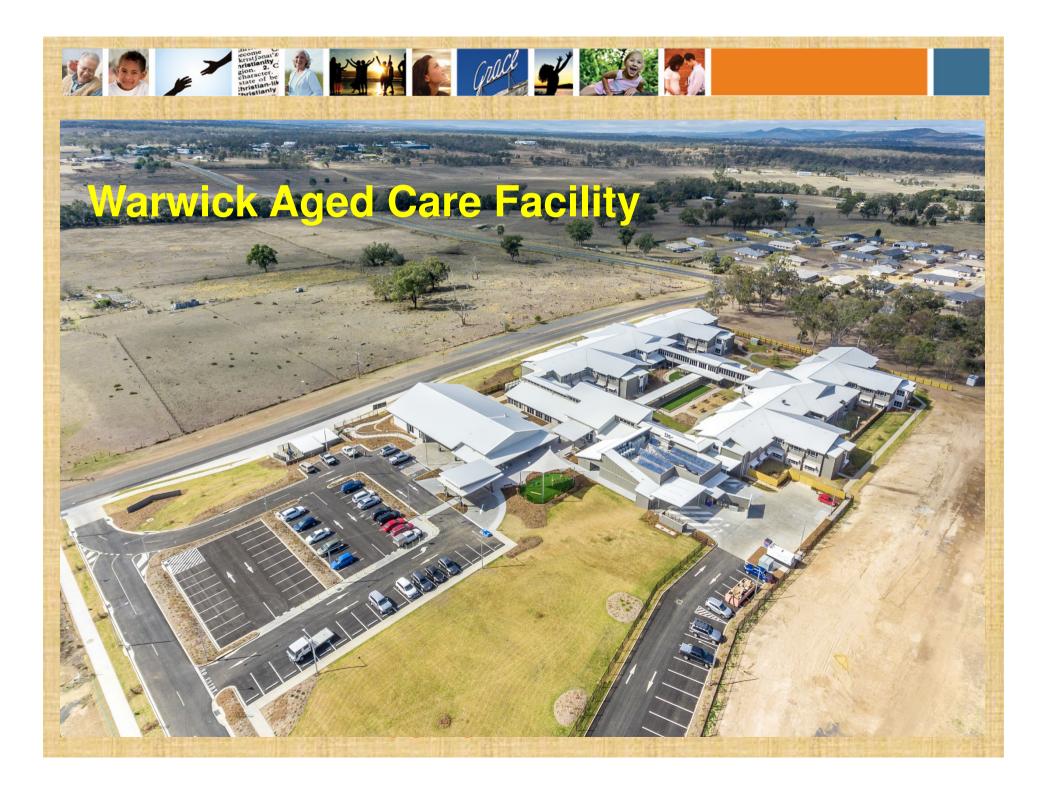

Churches of Christ Fleet...



- Nearly 600 fleet assets
 Passenger 74%, Commercial 13%, Plant 13%
- Fleet is purchased (manufacturer/dealer) and disposed via auction
- 10.6 M kilometres annually
 14 times to moon and back!



Churches of Christ Fleet...



- Pool & Packaged
 Pool (60%) and Packaged (40%)
- Fuel. 752,000 litres annually
- Maintenance through Smartfleet
- Use Smartfleet for registrations, fuel cards and maintenance as well as system



Not for Profit Differences ..



- Fewer resources (\$, people, systems)
- Large volunteer base (1,500 volunteers)
- Large female workforce; high staff turnover
- Reliance on funding (clients and government)





Not for Profit Differences ..



- Care is the primary focus
- Procurement & Fleet seen as transactional rather than strategic
- Networking critical. Compare, benchmark, share ideas e.g. AfMA, PASA, and self-generated NFP network.





















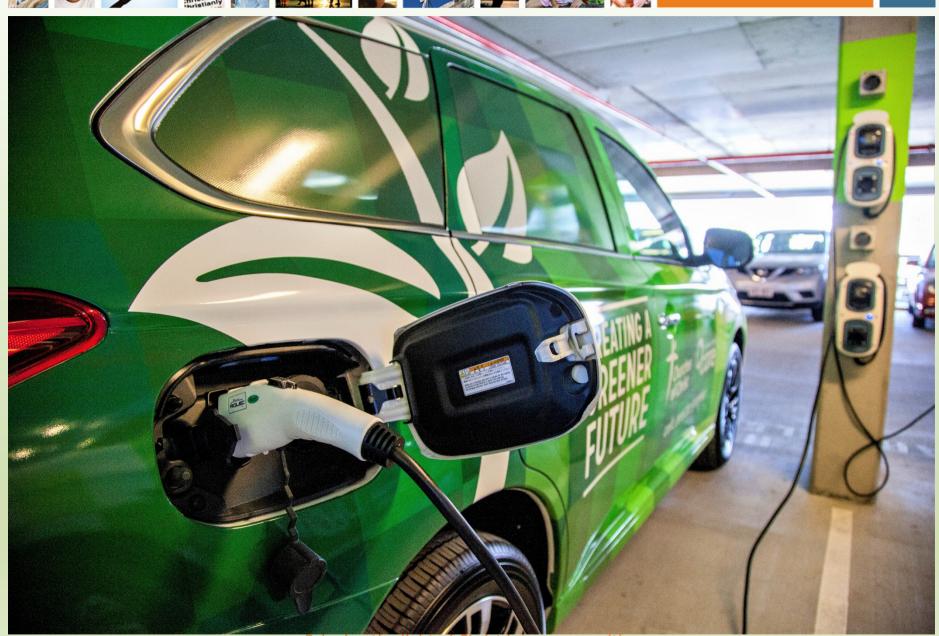


The Environment...



- Specifically not titled "Emissions"
- Why does this NFP care about the environment?
- Fleet strategy:
 - Vehicle purchases
 - Purchase vehicles with lowest CO₂ emissions where practicable
 - 2 x PHEV Outlanders charged from solar panels (200kW)
 - 18 Corolla hybrids
 - Staff's concerns regarding 'complexity' and range
 - No diesels (cross fuelling and particulates) some Commercials

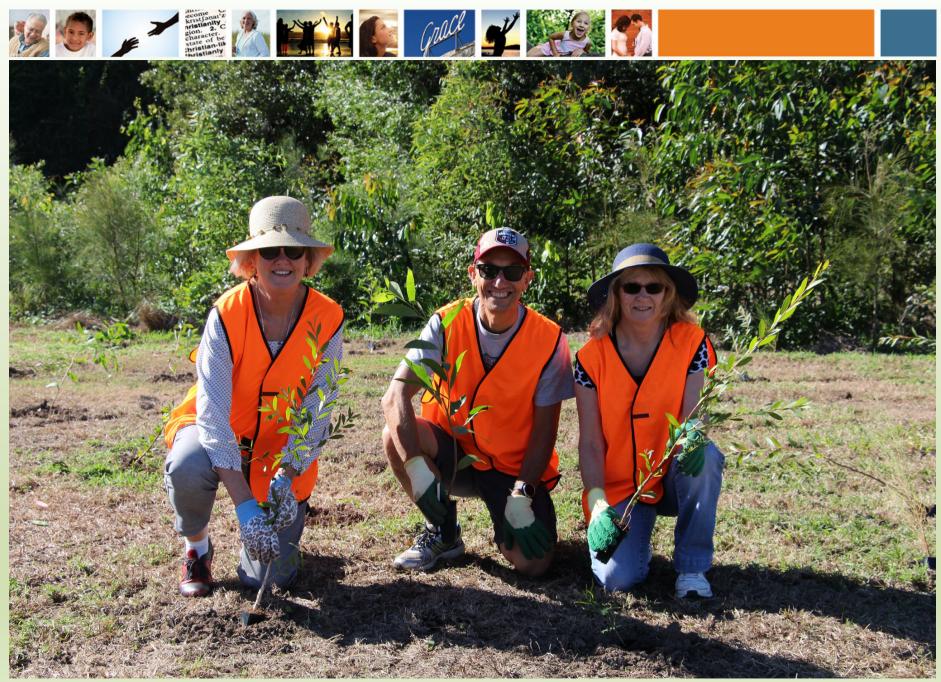




The Environment...



- Strategy (continued):
 - Greenfleet
 - Over 14,000 native trees planted to date, offsetting 4,000 tonnes CO₂-e.
 - Benefits of employee engagement at tree planting and broader staff interest
 - Turtles!

 - Potential for IVMS
