




# Who is the Fleet Management Business Group (FMBIG)?

FMBIG members have acted as initiators and negotiators with vehicle manufacturers, importers, dealerships, vehicle disposal agents and key industry stakeholders such as ANCAP regarding minimum safety standards for public sector vehicle fleets. FMBIG members have been innovative leaders in safety, environmental, social and financial initiatives relating to all aspects of fleet management and the NPSFMC is the mechanism for sharing this knowledge with all levels of government.


#### Fleets in Transition to Net Zero – sharing the journey














# **Registration Policies**

Cancellation of a registration before **27 October 2023** will result in a 50% refund. Cancellations made after that date are not refundable.



# **Conference Floor Plan**



# **Transport & Parking**

#### **Train**

There is no rail link from the airport to the city centre.

Craigieburn line from Melbourne CBD's Flinders Street Station & Southern Cross station stops at Moonee Ponds Station (Approx. 30 mins). Moonee Valley Racing Club is a 10 minute walk down Puckle Street.

#### Taxi / Rideshare (From Airport to venue)

Taxis are available 24/7 from sheltered ranks located on the ground floor outside T1 and in the T4 Transport Hub.

For an estimate on your fare cost, click here. Remember that toll road fees are in addition to any cab fare and are the responsibility of the passenger. A Melbourne Airport access fee of \$4.78 (inc GST) applies to all pick-ups from an airport taxi rank. The fee is included in the taxi fare, and there is no airport charge for drop-off.

Outside of peak periods, it is approximately a 20 minute drive from the airport to the Moonee Valley Racing Club.



Rideshare drivers Pick-up passengers from two locations:

The drop off and pick up point for all ride share vehicles is the Tote Park Turnstiles on the corner of Alexandra Ave and Feehan Ave, Moonee Ponds (refer to Gate 2).



#### **Tram**
