





Who is the Fleet Management Business Group (FMBIG)?

The National Public Sector Fleet Managers' Conference (NPSFMC) is an annual initiative of the Fleet Management Business Improvement Group (FMBIG) which comprises all Australian Commonwealth (1), State (6) and Territory (2) Government Fleet Managers who meet periodically for knowledge sharing, benchmarking and networking. FMBIG members have acted as initiators and negotiators with vehicle manufacturers, importers, dealerships, vehicle disposal agents and key industry stakeholders such as ANCAP regarding minimum safety standards for public sector vehicle fleets. FMBIG members have been innovative leaders in safety, environmental, social and financial initiatives relating to all aspects of fleet management and the NPSFMC is the mechanism for sharing this knowledge with all levels of government.

National Public Sector Fleet Managers' Conference

The National Fleet Managers' Conference brings together the Commonwealth, State, Territory and Local Government Fleet Managers together in one place to hold key meetings and to stage an event focusing on standards, policy, issues, opportunities, and partnerships in fleet management. Importantly, the Conference also focuses on the future – trends, emerging technology and changing patterns around mobility. The conference includes local government fleet managers and suppliers. Fleets across passenger vehicles, 4WD, police vehicles and yellow fleet are included. The delegation is made up of government representatives and government funded research and policy organisations.






Delegates by Sector represented at NPSFMC 2022

The National Public Sector Fleet Managers Conference (NPSFMC) is returning to Melbourne on 28 and 29 November 2023 and kicks off on the evening of 27 November with a networking cocktail event. 


Networking, Partnering, Supporting and Exhibiting





Conference Floor Plan


